ISUZU PLAZA

As part of a project commemorating the 80th anniversary of the establishment of ISUZU Motors Limited, ISUZU Plaza opened in April 2017 next to Fujisawa Plant.

The Plaza aims to bring ISUZU closer to visitors by introducing the role of commercial vehicles; ISUZU's Monozukuri (art of manufacturing) and operational support to keep customers' vehicles on the road; and the history of ISUZU.

ISUZU Plaza also offers Monozukuri craft workshops and guided facility tours to serve as a place bringing the local community together.

By train

Get off at Shonandai Station on Odakyu Enoshima Line, Soetsu Izumino Line, or Yokohama Municipal Subway Blue Line. Free shuttle buses available from Shonandai Station (East Exit Bus Stop No.3).

By car

Approx. 10 km from Ebina Interchange on Metropolitan Inter-City Expressway (Ken-O Expressway)
Approx. 11 km from Totsuka Tollgate on Yokohama Bypass
Visitor parking is available and subject to availability.
For those who visit by charter bus, please contact us in advance. Parking for charter buses is available only on weekdays.




One of Japan's largest dioramas displays trucks and buses - both essential in everyday life - to bring a sense of connection between your everyday life and ISUZU vehicles.
